2019 Novel Coronavirus

In December 2019, local health facilities in Wuhan, China identified clusters of pneumonia patients which seemed to be connected to a local market. Following this discovery, laboratory studies revealed a new coronavirus present in the patients' samples, nicknamed [2019-nCoV](#). 2019-nCoV has since spread to 16 countries and is being closely monitored by international health organizations.
