### Vaping-Associated Illnesses

Reports of characteristic patterns of illness and lung injury associated with electronic cigarette (e-cigarette) use began in March 2019 and continue to present. The illnesses have an unknown etiology, but symptoms include cough, shortness of breath, nausea, fatigue, chest and abdominal pain. Symptoms have been reported amongst both THC and nicotine e-cigarette users, and have not yet been connected to any specific product or brand.
