## **Ebola**



Ebola Virus Disease in Africa, 1976 – 2014, (from the CDC).

Ebola virus disease (formerly known as Ebola haemorrhagic fever) is a severe, often fatal illness, with a death rate of up to 90%. It is caused by a genus of viruses called Ebolavirus, and first appeared in 1976 in two simultaneous outbreaks, one in a village near the Ebola River in the Democratic Republic of Congo, and the other in a remote area of Sudan. Ebola can cause disease in humans and nonhuman primates (monkeys, gorillas, and chimpanzees).
