
RGH Medical Library Joins HUBNET - a new gateway to our library resources -

What is HUBNET?

Hospitals and University at Buffalo Library Resource Network (HUBNET) is a collaborative library project serving hospitals and healthcare organizations throughout Western New York.

The **Medical Library** at **RGH** is now a member of this network.

Through HUBNET you have internet access to our library resources – databases, electronic books, and electronic journals – all in one location from any location, except where restricted by license agreements.

Who may access HUBNET?

Anyone employed by, or affiliated with, **Rochester General Health System**.

How do I access HUBNET from the RGHS Network?

Click on the blue HUBNET button from the Medical Library page on the portal.

No username or password is required.

How do I access HUBNET from a Non-RGHS Network?

Access HUBNET from the internet at <http://hubnet.buffalo.edu>.

You will be prompted for a username and password on the HUBNET homepage.

First time users:

Click on the “**Need an Account**” link in the bottom left-hand corner.

Complete the required information. You will receive an email confirming the creation of your HUBNET account. Your account will be deactivated if affiliation cannot be verified.

Hint: It is best to use your RGHS email address.

Are there restrictions on how I use HUBNET?

HUBNET should be used for research, education/training, clinical or academic purposes only.
