Primary Drug Database for RGHS Changing to Lexicomp

The primary drug information database for Rochester General Health System will change from **Micromedex** to **Lexicomp** beginning September 30, 2013.

In June of 2012, staff of the Werner Medical Library, the Pharmacy Department, medical staff, and members of the Library Committee formed a task force to discuss the high cost of Micromedex and to explore alternative resources for drug information. The task force decided to evaluate Lexicomp, a direct competitor to Micromedex. Lexicomp training sessions were provided and a side- by-side comparison of the two databases was conducted. Members of the task force discussed the evaluation and recommended replacing Micromedex with Lexicomp.

By selecting Lexicomp as the primary drug database, the hospital will save approximately \$31,000 per year. Highlights from the evaluation include:

- Lexicomp offers robust drug information, toxicology and patient education materials.
- Lexicomp provides both the King Guide and Trissel's IV-Chek for checking IV compatibility and stability.
- Many respondents were able to find answers more quickly in Lexicomp than Micromedex.
- 85% of respondents felt that Lexicomp contained patient education information appropriate to their patients.

- 1. From your device's browser (i.e. Safari), go to <u>http://www.lexi.com/codes/?universal=AKB4VVZ52D4D</u>
- 2. Select your device from the drop down menu.
- 3. Copy the product code, which appears in red.

- 5. At the bottom of the window that opens, select *Create Account*.
- 6. Complete the form and paste in the product code. Click *Submit*.
- 7. Go to your device's application store.
- 8. Search for and install the Lexicomp application.
- 9. Open the app and sign in with your account information.
