THE ECONOMICS OF HOSPITAL ACQUIRED INFECTIONS

Annually, approximately 2 million patients suffer from healthcare-associated infections (HAIs) in the US and nearly 90,000 are estimated to die. The estimated overall annual direct cost of HAIs to U.S. hospitals ranges from \$5 billion dollars (CDC) to as much as \$16 billion dollars.
